PIT LOCATION

The pit area will be at the Marine Stadium Car Park, Muriel Henchmen Drive, the Spit, Main Beach. Boats and Transporters are to be in the pit area by **8.00 am Saturday**.

PIT AREA

Teams are advised to have bunting or banner fencing for their allocated pit area. Ground sheets are also mandatory for pits. Team pit arrears are to be maintained as tidy as possible. (Pit area will be fenced) See officials for allocated position.

All teams must wear enclosed foot wear in the pit area. Team uniforms is mandatory on Sunday,

Also preferred Saturday. teams are required to have their own fire extinguisher in their pits.

When pits are open **no drinking or smoking** will be condoned within the confines of the pit areas.

Speed limit for any motorised scooters in the confines of the pit may not exceed a speed 15kph.

Teams need to clear their allocated Pit Area at the end of the event. This includes removal of all fuel **drums** and any **rubbish. (\$50.00 PENALTY IF LEFT BEHIND)**

OVERNIGHT SECURITY Friday: 5.30am- 7am **Saturday:** 6pm to 7am

Sunday Day: 7am to 4pm & **Sunday Night:** 6pm to Monday 9.00am

VIP/ HOSPITALITY

10.30am to 4.30pm. This will include Morning & afternoon tea, buffet lunch, Beer, Wine, Soft drink, Tea and Coffee. Pit Access Pass & souvenir lanyard, Drivers are encouraged to visit the VIP Marquee and mingle with Guests.

Entrants can pre-purchase 6 tickets at \$80pp. (retail \$120pp) by indicating and paying with Entry Children 12 years and under are ½ price. (Children are required to be supervised at all times)

MEMBERSHIP

Support Categories (Monos, Jet Skis,) will be required to pay Series membership, cost **\$110.00 (inc GST)**. The Series reserves the right to reject, accept or accept without provisions any application. A series entry may be granted, cancelled, revoked, suspended or reinstated at any time.

All team owners are responsible for their crew and associated persons. Note: Team passes need to be worn, otherwise you will have to pay a pit entry fee Sunday. Any team member handing passes back and forth to allow additional persons to enter the pits or without a pass may jeopardise that teams points.

LICENCING

F1, F2000 & F3 Competitors require a 2006 F1 Superboat Series licence; cost **\$400.00 (inc GST)**.

All individuals wishing to operate racing equipment in events of the Australian Formula One Superboat Series are required to have held a form of race licence within the last two years. For those that haven't held a race licence they are required to undergo an immersion test (for F1, F2000 and F3 boats), for new drivers a delayed start will be subject to the Grand Marshal's discretion.

BREATH TESTING

All Drivers and Officials are required to undergo a breath test and register a zero blood alcohol reading.

PRESENTATION

A television podium presentation will take place (VIP Marquee) following the final FORMULA ONE race.

START DOCK

All F1 teams will be required to bring holding poles for launching, retrieving and holding boats. Craning slings will also be required. (Beach Start)

TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING

Boats will be weighed, scrutineered and fuel testing may be conducted to ensure compliance with the Rules and Regulations, This may be random. Boats that have had prior notices in regards to rectifying safety scrutineering issues will not race until rectified.

TURN BUOYS

Drivers should note that striking and or damaging a buoy carries a fine of \$990.00, in addition to a one lap penalty for touching a turn buoy.

Any outstanding/prior buoy infringement payment will need to be finalised prior to competing at the next round.

WET EXHAUST

Due to noise restrictions all competing boats are required to run water through their exhausts. This will be strictly enforced.

F1, F2000, F3 entry fee: \$363.00 (Inc GST)

Support classes: \$110.00 (Inc GST)

Any F1 Entrant without a Series Level Agreement

Will be required to pay an additional Entry levy of \$880.00 (inc GST) per event.

Any F2000 Entrant without a Series Level Agreement

Will be required to pay an additional Entry levy of \$550.00 (inc GST) per event.

Entrants are required to complete the Driver Profile form with their entry.

This information will assist commentators and media prior to the Event.

Paperwork and Fees are to be lodged together or a late Fee will apply [\$50.00]

Changes

- Paperwork – Series and Level paperwork will not be completed at the event. Entries will no longer be accepted at the event, please ensure entries are received by FOSBS via fax, email or post. And are completed in full.
- All boats must display race numbers in a clear and legible manner, Digit Size min 24 x 4 cm Black and on a white area of min 32 x 40. Exemptions for stylised/sponsors logo numbers may be approved at the discretion of the Series Chief Timekeeper. Any number not clearly displayed, as determined by the Chief Timekeeper, will need to be changed.
- Any driver interviewed on TV must appear in either their driving suit or team uniform and must appear neat, tidy and conduct themselves in a professional manner. (Interviews will be excluded that do not meet the above criteria).
- Persons wishing to advertise their boat for sale may do so preferably on an A frame at their pits or on the forum of the F1 web site, also advice on profile for commentators to announce. It is preferred that no boat has signage advertising it for sale due to the fact that photos and footage can not be used for media etc.

Any team breaching the following conditions will jeopardise their Teams points for the event
